### Veteran Health Services will make a difference

- ★ **Experience.** In addition to having the requisite licensing to practice their profession, each of the social workers, psychologists, psychiatrists, and counselors employed by Veteran Health Services will receive a minimum of 80 hours' clinical training on military culture and veteran-specific care / issues.
- ★ **Accessibility.** Veterans and their families will be offered access to care regardless of the veteran's level of service connection, without restrictions associated with adherence to a third party's traditional concept of "medical necessity" or their ability to pay.
- ★ **Confidentiality.** Veteran Health Services is not affiliated with the U.S. military, Veteran Administration (VA) or any other governmental agency. Our independent structure alleviates potential concerns about confidentiality, promotion and security clearance while opening channels of healing for those who need and deserve it most.
- ★ **Comfort.** Our services will be provided in a clinic that is spacious and well-appointed, accessible, warm, and welcoming.
- ★ **Technology.** Advances will continue to streamline our practice, including 24-hour live access to staff members via telehealth, Electronic Health Records (EHR) that maximize efficiency and minimize errors, and a proprietary mobile application designed to empower patients with immediate access to their personal treatment plans.
